“THE 3RD COVID-19 WAVE TAKING ITS TOLL ON LIFE IN PAKISTAN”

SITUATION

- Pakistan has reported 3447 new cases and 78 deaths during last 24 hours
- 4,824 COVID recoveries have been reported during last 24 hours
- National positivity ratio was recorded at 8.54 %.
- The number of vaccine doses given to people has reached to 3.32million.

- Pakistan on Saturday May 8th began a nine-day strict shutdown affecting travel and tourist hotspots in a bid to prevent a surge in COVID-19 cases during the Eid holidays.

Food Security and Livelihoods



The effects of the COVID-19 have led to increased food commodity prices and unemployment, limiting livelihood opportunities, particularly for the most vulnerable households. The number of people in critical need of food security and livelihoods assistance is projected to increase to over 6.1 million people in June 2021. Food and Agriculture organization launched the appeal of USD 16million to meet the needs.

Economic Relief and Recovery



Pushing back the people once again into the crises of earning, there is time rising up again to meet people's immediate survival needs of food security and livelihoods.

Inclusivity



The response activities must give special considerations to the protection and inclusion of the most vulnerable categories of the affected populations, including women, children, elderly, persons with disabilities, religious minorities, transgenders, etc.

IMPACT OF COVID-19

As per an integrated analysis of socio-economic and environmental impacts of COVID-19 on Pakistan conducted by Pubmed & NIH, estimates an economic loss of about 10%, i.e. 1.1 trillion PKR, will be observed in the FY 2021. Certain pandemic impediment measures like lockdowns, social distancing and travel restrictions have been thoroughly analyzed to determine how they impacted the livelihoods of nearly 7.15 million workers. Consequently, a rise of 33.7% of poverty level is projected.

"IMPACT OF COVID-19 ON THE LIVELIHOODS OF CHRISTIANS IN PAKISTAN"

(A study Conducted by Pakistan Partnership Initiative (PPI) with the support of its partners across Pakistan)

- 70 percent of the Christian wage workers, laborers and job holders' income affected
- 7 out of 10 families' livelihood in Christian communities affected
- 80 percent businesses closed or collapsed in Christian communities during the lock down.
- Church income declined by 80 %, the lockdown has adversely affected the income of schools and hospitals operated by the Churches.
- Decline in the social activities held at Church is impacting harmony.
