SITUATION

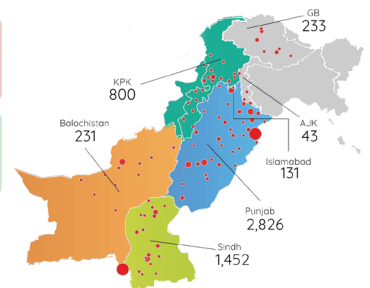
- Sixty-nine percent (69%) of the reported cases fall in the age bracket of 20-59 years, 17.5 % cases recorded are among people of 60 or above years while 10.57% of the cases are in 20 or younger age group. Fifty percent (50%) of total cases reported so far are men between 20-59 years age. (WHO Pakistan).
- Chairman National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA) Lieutenant General Muhammad Afzal said Pakistan has the testing facility available for 75-days to diagnose Coronavirus or COVID-19 pandemic disease.
- Prime Minister Imran Khan on Saturday said the incentives announced by the central bank for the business community would prevent massive unemployment in the county because of the economic downturn caused by the coronavirus pandemic as the health minister warned against easing restrictions at the current stage of the outbreak.

Anita Nadeem, a widow and mother of six (6) children from Adra, Rawalpindi serves as a housemaid. The COVID-19 shut down throughout the country has severely affected her household income. She says, I am out of a job for the last 20 days and I was afraid what will I do at the end of the month when I'm still without salary. This financial help is more than a miracle for me and my children since I will be able to bring food ration today on my way back home". Shahida Saleem, a resident of Dheri Hasanabad, Rawalpindi was used to earn her living by serving as a butler at someone's house before the breakout of COVID-19, followed by the shutdown on the national level. Her husband is ill for the past few years and she is the sole provider of the family. She received Cash Grant and health items during SRD Cash Grant and Health items distribution on 9th of April at St. Joseph's Cathedrals, Bishop House Rawalpindi. She said, "With the provision of this aid my family does not have to worry about sleeping on an empty stomach.
