


#Covid19 #SocialDistancing #CoronaUpdate #TogetherAtHome



SITUATION

- The number of confirmed COVID-19 cases in Pakistan has risen to 9,226 as of 21st April, 2016. Increase of 798 new cases in last 24 hours.
- The most affected province due to COVID-19 virus is Punjab 4,195, followed by Sindh 2,764. According to a report by the Federal Government, Pakistan could expect 50,000 cases of disease by 25th April.
- Evidence shows that the principal means of an exponential increase in infected cases of Novel CoronaVirus is community/local transmission.
- With the holy month of Ramazan commencing later this week, the role of national communications strategy for Covid-19 pandemic has become pivotal for containing the disease.


