# CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19) SITUATION REPORT

"A GLIMPSE OF COLLECTIVE EFFORT OF CHRISTIAN HUMANITARIAN ACTORS RESPONDING TO

### **SITUATION**

 According to PIDE (Pakistan Institute of Development Economics), around 2.4% of the Annual GDP will be lost due to COVID-19, which is enough to send the country into a spiraling recession.

Total Confirmed

- Staggering figures from an IRC (International Rescue Committee) report claim, 60% of children are unengaged at home, 22% are being taught by parents, 9% reported schools are assessing homework over WhatsApp, while 3% are getting education from radio and 3% from online classes.
- Pakistan has made assessment of Covid-19 pandemic effects on the country's GDP growth ranging from 0.8 to 1.3 percent and decided to prepare an action plan for social/economic fronts in consultation with the World Bank (WB) to mitigate negative impacts.


