

COVID-19 SITUATION REPORT

“A GLIMPSE OF COLLECTIVE EFFORT OF CHRISTIAN HUMANITARIAN ACTORS RESPONDING TO THE COVID-19 CRISIS IN PAKISTAN ”

SITUATION

- The number of confirmed COVID-19 cases in Pakistan has risen to **85,264** as of 04 June. Increase of **4,688** new cases and **82** deaths in the last 24 hours.
- Mental health services are an essential part of all government responses to COVID-19. They must be expanded and fully funded, said UN secretary in his message at the launch of policy brief on COVID-19 and mental health.
- The lockdown and global economic shock has the potential to throw up to **125** million people in Pakistan below the poverty line. This will disproportionately impact the vulnerable and marginalized groups, such as women and children, daily-wage workers, small and medium enterprises, agriculture, and other informal sectors.
- The National Coordination Committee (NCC) has decided to observe two-day complete lockdown (Saturday and Sunday) in a week across the country besides making decisions for the partial resumption of trains service and repatriation of overseas Pakistanis.

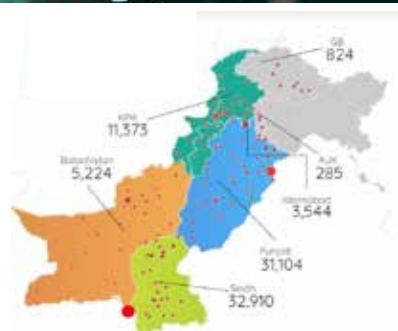

Let's be watchful to myths: Advice for Public

- COVID-19 is NOT transmitted through houseflies or mosquito bites
- Spraying and introducing bleach or another disinfectant into your body WILL NOT protect you against Covid-19 and can be dangerous
- 5G mobile networks DO NOT spread COVID-19
- Exposing yourself to the sun or to temperatures higher than 25C degree DOES NOT prevent the coronavirus disease
- Being able to hold your breath for 10 seconds or more without coughing or feeling discomfort DOES NOT mean you are free from COVID-19 or any other lung disease
- COVID-19 can be transmitted in the areas with hot and humid climates
- Catching corona the virus DOES NOT mean to have it for life. Recovery is possible
